

English 521 - Rich for One Day Written Activity

Type: Standard

Due: Tuesday, March 24, 2009

Description:

On March 13, we read and discussed 'Rich for One Day' by Susanne Jacobs.

In the short fictional story, the character is living her perfect day so - in a lot of ways - she is 'rich' without actually having any money.

Your task in this activity is to create your own 'Rich for a Day' piece of writing. Remember that you're 'rich', but not in the monetary sense. You must describe a day where you live 'richly' (meaning that you are 'rich' without having a pocketful of money).



These pieces of writing must be 300-500 words (no more and no less), written in good copy, double-spaced, typed or neatly-written, and submitted on Tuesday, March 24.

All Submissions Shall Be Assessed Using a Four Point Scale:

- 4 - Outstanding writing, solid flow of ideas, no distinguishable errors in spelling and grammar.
- 3 - Strong writing, solid flow of ideas, some errors in spelling and grammar (not affecting readability).
- 2 - Adequate writing, somewhat stunted flow of ideas, several mechanical errors which affect readability.
- 1 - Weak writing, ideas do not flow well, too many mechanical errors which confuse the piece entirely.
