Speech Specifics

- Each presenter must have a representative slide show (10-12 slides) to accompany his/her speech (the content of the slide must apply to the content of your speech at given intervals)

- Each audience member is required to ask a minimum of two questions (tedious question posers will be silenced).

Expectations

- Each student shall be required to submit a good copy of his/her symposium speech (whether you speak off the cuff or not) and a properly-formatted Works Cited sheet.
- Symposium topic choices must be delivered by Monday, January 12.

Topics Addressed
